Many publishers reject good manuscripts, not because of the quality of the writing or the importance of the work, but because the topic is too specialized or the market too small. Our mission is to expose important manuscripts that challenge popular norms, explain new ways of doing things, or examine scholarly ideas that may not seem profitable enough to large corporate publishers. We believe in fairly compensating the author, making each book easily obtainable through major bookselling channels, and presenting each title in a credible forum.

Like traditional publishing houses we are selective about what we publish. However, innovations in manuscript acquisition and book manufacturing have made it possible for us to successfully publish many manuscripts that were too risky for other publishers. Our academic imprint, Dissertation.com, was among the first to offer ebook distribution and adopt print on-demand technology. By working closely with the author throughout the publishing process we can bring many books to market quickly and efficiently that would be difficult for other publishers. Although we do not offer monetary advances, we pay competitive royalties. And unlike many small POD publishers, we charge no publishing fee to authors.

- **Author Friendly Publishing Agreement**

No publishing fee. Author keeps all copyrights. Easily terminable contract after 1000 copies sold or two years, whichever comes first.

- **Author Royalties**

Royalties are based on the retail price so you know exactly how much each sale is worth. Authors can receive one of the highest royalties in the publishing business: from 10% to 40% of the retail price depending on the mode and the level of the sale.

- **Speed**

Many submissions are ready to promote and distribute in just six to nine weeks depending on how well the manuscript is prepared.

- **Control**

You can control many aspects of your publication including the editing, page layout, and cover design by submitting your manuscript ready to publish. Complex tables, charts, figures, symbols and photos are no problem if you submit your manuscript in PDF format.

All our titles are made available through hundreds of on-line booksellers including giants such as Amazon.com and BarnesAndNoble, and via special order through thousands of neighborhood bookstores. Large scale wholesale distribution provided by arrangement with top book distributors including Ingram Book Company and Baker & Taylor in the US, and Bertrams in Europe.

BrownWalker is interested non-fiction, academic, technical and scientific work. We prefer specialized topics, but matters of wide appeal that have not been well written about are welcome. We do not publish fiction, poetry, memoirs, religious or personal philosophy. Although our aim is to expose as many important manuscripts as possible, we have a limited amount of resources to prepare new manuscripts. Therefore, in deciding between equally deserving works we must choose the manuscript that is best prepared for publication.

Our publications are sold in paperback through thousands of booksellers including Amazon.com, Barnes&Noble, and directly via the internet. In addition to global internet distribution, we share printing and distribution facilities with some of the largest publishers in the world to ensure quality manufacturing and easy access to all of our titles. ## Author Royalties

Most books are priced starting at \$17.95 in paper and \$9.00 for the ebook edition. Royalties range between 10% and 40% of the retail price depending on mode and level of the sale (see Publishing Agreement for details). For the first 999 copies sold the author receives a 10% royalty when sold at a discount or through a bookseller, and 20% royalty when purchased at the retail price directly from BrownWalker. Upon the sale of the 1000th copy, the author receives a 20% royalty for additional copies sold through booksellers, and a 40% royalty when purchased at the retail price directly from BrownWalker Press.

## Author Friendly Publishing Agreement

THE PUBLISHER, BrownWalker, agrees to assign a publisher's ISBN and offer the work for sale.

The Publisher agrees to pay the author a royalty of ten percent (10%) of the regular retail price of the book on sales of the work after the first three copies sold in each calendar quarter when ordered through a bookseller at our standard discount, and twenty percent (20%) of the regular retail price on all sales after the first three copies sold in each calendar quarter when purchased directly from BrownWalker at the regular retail price. Royalties are payable 45 days following the end of

each calendar quarter. Authors may purchase copies of their own book at 40% off the regular retail price.

*Royalty rate doubles after the first 1000 copies sold.*

*Authors can purchase copies of their own book in any quantity at 40% off the retail price. Author orders over 100 copies receive a 50% discount. Copies purchased at the author discount are non-commissionable and do not count toward royalties. Author royalties are paid quarterly and apply to all sales after the first three copies sold in each calendar quarter.*

Upon the sale of the 1000th book, The Publisher agrees to pay the author a royalty of twenty percent (20%) of the regular retail price on sales of the work after the first three copies sold in each calendar quarter when ordered through a bookseller at our standard discount, and forty percent (40%) of the regular retail price on all sales after the first three copies in each calendar quarter when purchased from BrownWalker at the regular retail price.

The author shall be given an opportunity to review the final version of the Work prior to its release. Publication of any BrownWalker title requires agreement between the Author and The Publisher on the final content of the Work.

THE AUTHOR, agrees to submit the Work to BrownWalker completely copy edited and ready to publish in the computer file format and layout specified by The Publisher.

The Author understands that it is his or her sole responsibility to obtain any copyright permission necessary to publish the Work. The Author guarantees to The

Publisher that [a] nothing in the work is plagiarized or infringes any existing copyright; [b] the Work contains no matter that is defamatory, libelous, slanderous, an invasion of privacy, or otherwise unlawful; and [c] the Author holds all necessary rights to enable BrownWalker to publish the Work and has obtained all relevant consents for the purposes of this Agreement. The Author agrees to indemnify and hold The Publisher harmless against any claim, demand, suit, action, proceeding, prosecution or judgment, based upon The Publisher's exercise of the rights conferred by this Agreement, including all reasonable expenses, losses, penalties, legal fees, and liabilities suffered or incurred.

The Author grants BrownWalker the exclusive right to reproduce and distribute, in whole or in part, the Work entitled below in both paper and electronic form for two years, or until 1000 copies are sold, which ever comes first. Either party may terminate this agreement for any reason after the two year period, or after 1000 copies are sold, which ever comes first, by giving 90 days prior written notice. It is the author's responsibility to notify BrownWalker of changes in his or her email and mailing address so they can be contacted about royalties and other information regarding this Agreement.

## Inquires & Book Proposals

Please submit your book proposal electronically using the book proposal form at the BrownWalker.com website. Be prepared to provide a brief explanation of the book, a description of the anticipated market for the book, alternative sources of information, the author's qualifications, promotional resources, and the format of the manuscript.

A representative will respond to your inquiry in about a week. If interested, we will ask to see your manuscript. Although you may submit a draft for review, it is vital that your manuscript be in sound editorial shape when you submit the final revision for publication. All copy editing should be complete. We refer some authors to a typesetter or graphic designer for complicated layouts.
